Admission Requirements:

Direct Admission

SAT 1140 / ACT 23 / Psychometric 575

+ High School Diploma with a GPA of at least 3.3 on a 4.0 scale (or 85%).

Or a Bachelor's Degree with a GPA of at least 3.3 on a 4.0 scale (or 85%).

Or Completion of 40 Academic Credit Points with a GPA of at least 3.3 on a 4.0 scale (or 85%).

Mechina/Preparatory Program

Applicants who do not meet the direct admission requirements may apply to the Mechina/Preparatory Program, which requires a high school diploma with a GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or 80%).

General Information:

Studies take place at the Kiryat Ono Campus.

Program Structure: A 3.5-year program, five days a week (Sunday to Thursday), including Ulpan classes.

The program includes 1,000 hours of supervised clinical training.

Tuition: \$ 14,150 per academic year (3.5-year program).

Scholarships: Internal scholarships are available, including those for Lone Soldiers, outstanding students, and students from challenging socioeconomic backgrounds.

External scholarships are also offered, including scholarships from the Ministry of Aliyah and Integration, as well as from organizations such as Perach, IMPACT, and Mifal HaPais.
